	Provider	50	5-5½"	[CBMV,NY15 , PM, DM]	Highest early yield, even under adverse conditions.
	Vermont Cranberry	fresh/ 85 dry	6"		New England tradition since before 1800. Pods contain 5 to 6 speckled cranberry-colored shell beans. Reliable, hardy and easy to shell.
BEET	Bull's Blood	35-58			A beautiful heirloom! Pick early, for leaves; at 58 days, for roots.
BROCCOLI	Packman F1	58			Dark green, largely-beaded heads, with good head weight.
BRUSSELS SPROUT	Jade Cross	90			Mild, abundant, easy to grow.
CABBAGE	Market Prize	76	4 lb.		Head matures to best quality in cool weather. Harvest when firm.
	Napa 'Rubicon' * F1	52	11-12"		Great chinese cabbage. Plant spring or fall. Resists bolting.
	Pak Choi 'Mei Qing' F1	40			Tasty, tender, vigorous baby "Pak Choy." Slow to bolt;very tolerant.
	Ruby Perfection F1	85	3½ lb.		Heads are sweet and slow to burst. The #1 mid-late red cabbage!

CELERY	Summertime	82	7" stalks		Compact 20" plant; 7" stalks.

CORN	Spring Treat	71			Twice as sweet as other yellow corn; high disease-resistance.
CUCUMBER	Burpless 26 F1	60		[DM, PM,CMV]	Very compact, productive, Japanese type; smooth, dark-green fruit.
	Bush Pickle	54	4-5"		Bush-type habit, for a small garden. Very popular.
	Diva	58	4-5"	[s,DM,PM]	AAS winner! Seedless, crisp, tender, non-bitter slicing cucumber. Harvest small for a very flavorful taste.
	Marketmore 76	58	8-9"	[s,CMV, DM, PM]	Popular non-hybrid in the North. Great producer, even under stress.
	Northern Pickling	50-55	3-5"		Longtime favorite. High-yield, early; good for small garden, northern climate.
EGGPLANT	Imperial Black Beauty	80			Vigorous producer: up to 12 large, glossy blackish-purple fruit! Very adaptable.
	Orient Express* F1	58	8-10"		Oriental style long, black, tender fruit; delicate flavor, quick-cooking.
GREENS	Arugula	35			Tender young leaves, peppery flavor. Great in spring salad mix.
KALE	Kale Mix	60-63			Medley of diverse colors, patterns, shapes. Best in cool weather! Grow spring and fall. Tasty leaves, great fresh or cooked.
	Ripbor F1	55			Beautiful curled leaves similar to Winterbor but more compact. Resists yellowing, leaf
LETTUCE	Bistro Salad Blend	30			Gourmet salad mix; exotic leaf shape; red, green and bronze colors.
	Black-seeded Simpson	40-60		[dm,wm,tb]	Very adaptable heirloom; sweet, crumpled leaves; succulent inner leaves. Never bitter; slow to bolt.
	Buttercrunch	65	4½"		Very tender sweet, crisp rosettes. Slow to bolt.
	Great Lakes Iceberg	90-100			Head cultivar w/large, erect outer leaves.
	Mesclun Mix	35-45	1-1½ lb.		Superb sweet, juicy flavor; small fruit. Great for container, patio. 4-5 lb. fruit per plant!
	Paris Island Romaine	65		[tb,lmv]	Vigorous and uniform, with a creamy white heart.
	Red Fire	51			Tender, sweet, light-red ruffled leaves. Among the last to bolt!
	Royal Oak	50			Tender dark-green, oak-leaf-shaped leaves. Very heat-resistant.
MELON	Superstar F1	86	6-8 lb.		Thick, salmon-colored flesh. (Tolerant to Fusarium wilt 1 & 2.)
	Sugar Baby	80	8-10 lb.		An early standard northern icebox. Dark-green outside, deep red inside.
OKRA	Clemson Spineless	50-60	2 ½-3"		AAS winner! Dark green, very productive, slightly grooved, straight, pointed pod; no spines. Great in soup!
ONION	Guardsman	50			Extremely early bunching onion (scallion) with long harvest period.
PEPPER	Better Belle F1	65	4½" x 3½"	[TMV]	Good-tasting, early. Blocky four-lobed shape. Maintains large fruit size, production all season.
	Cayenne	70-75	6" x ½"		Thin-walled, hot. Turns from dark green to bright red. Good for drying.
	Cubanelle F1	68	6" x 2½"		Semi-sweet fry type; waxy yellow-green fruit turns red when fully ripe.
	Golden Summer F1	65-70		[TMV]	High yield; mild, sweet, blocky-shaped fruit; bright-gold at maturity.
	Gypsy*	60	3-5"		AAS winner. Very prolific, early, sweet orange-to-red pepper.
	Habanero	95	1" x 1½"		The second-hottest pepper available. Light green to orange.
	Jalapeno	75-80	3"		Productive and hot; pick green or red. Good fresh!
	Red Beauty F1	68	4" x 3½"	[TMV]	High yield of early, thick-walled, four-lobed, very sweet red peppers.
	Super Chili F1	75	2½" x 1½"		Productive, semi-compact; spicy, cone-shaped. Great as an ornamental.
	Tabasco*	80			Vigorous; high yield; extremely hot; used in the famous extra-hot sauce.
	Thai Dragon F1	50-70	2½"		Heavy yield; very hot, small, slender, pointy fruit. Thin flesh, great for Asian cooking! Harvest at 50 days, green; 70, red.

	Howden	115	20-30 lb.		Good yield; medium-large, standard deep-orange color; good handles.
	Small Sugar*	95-105	6 lb.		Early heirloom, good yield, great pie quality. Can be carved.
RADICCHIO	Treviso Red Preco	68			Most sought-after radicchio! Attractive, tender, crispy leaves, great in a salad. Turns a beautiful red w/white veins at onset of cool weather. Heirloom from Treviso, Italy.
SQUASH	F1	70-78			Semi-bushy, slightly early acorn type; good yield.
	Early Butternut F1	85	10"-12"		Smooth, gold fruit grows on semi-bushy, compact plant.
	Delicata JS	100	1-1½ lb.		Unique cream-colored sweet fruit w/dark green stripes; excellent for stuffing or baking. Average yield 5-7 per plant.
	Flying Saucer F1	50	4"		Prolific flat, yellow, star-shaped fruit w/variegated center. Harvest from baby to mature stages.
	Multipik F1	50	7½-8"		Prolific, early, gold-yellow summer type. Long harvest period.
	Vegetable Spaghetti F1	100			Yellow, mid-size, oblong fruit; pale yellow at maturity. Harvest late summer, fall. A nutritious alternative to pasta!
	Ball's Zucchini F1	46	8-10"		Very productive bush; yields dark-green, uniform fruit.
SWISS CHARD	Bright Lights	60	2'		Vivid-colored stalks; delicious flavor. Great sauteed.
	Ruby Red	60	8-10"		Good yield, all season long. Shiny dark-green leaves, ruby-red stalks and veins. Good in salad, or steamed.
TOMATILLO	Toma Verde	60-75	2-3 oz.		Heavy yield of flavorful round green fruit. Great for sauce, salsa.
	Purple De Milpa	70-90	2-3 oz.		Vigorous, spreading; produces many deep-purple fruits. Eat raw, stewed, or in salsa.
