CUCUMBERS	Lemon	55-65	3-4"	[an,cub]	Abundant heirloom; produces very crisp, round fruit w/tender skin. Eat like an apple, right from your garden!
	Satsuki Madori	60-70	10-16"	[FVF,FNA]	Rare Asian variety produces delicious long, slender fruit; few seeds. A favorite of many, with a great following!
	Northern Pickling	50-55	3-5"		Longtime favorite high-yield, early cucumber. Good for small garden, Northern climates.
EGGPLANT	Santana	80	4x8.5"		High quality fruit that retains its glossy appearance well after harvest. Fewer spines, excellent yields. Does not fade in sun.
	Rosa Bianca	80-90	2 lb.		Hardy medium-size, incredibly delicious pink heirloom, from Arkansas. Excellent all-around: great flavor, good disease and crack resistance,; very abundant.
GROUND CHERRY	Cossack Pineapple	60	½"		Bite-size; extremely tasty. Children love it. Great for dessert topping, or just pick and enjoy!
GREENS	Black-seeded Simpson	40-60		[dm,wm,tb]	Very adaptable heirloom with sweet crumpled leaves, succulent inner leaves. Never bitter; slow to bolt.
	Freckles	50-70		[V,F1 & 2,NT]	Unusual, attractive spotted Romaine; tasty flavor. Slow to bolt. Pick young, or as full-sized head.
	Hyper Red Ruffled Wave*	50		[X, SC, DM,TB]	Very cold-tolerant, wavy red lettuce; great taste/texture.
	Sweet Mix*	21-40			A blend of gourmet greens.
	Pirat Butterhead	60		[dm,tb,wm, bhr]	Tender sweet variety; the highest disease resistance among butterheads. Green, with red tips.
	Sylvesta	52		[dm,LMV,]	Large-headed Boston type w/crisper, sturdier leaves.
MELON	Early Moonbeam	78	5-8 lb.		Early, icebox-sized, sweet yellow flesh.
	Crimson Sweet	90-100	15-25 lb.	[F1&2]	Sweet, crisp, juicy, red watermelon; 10-12". Tolerance to ANTH1, ANTH3.
	Arava	80	3 lb.	[PM]	Smooth, luscious, green-fleshed, signature Israeli cantaloupe. Produces well in cool conditions.
	Hales Best	80	1-1½ lb.		Very productive, sweet, deep-salmon colored heirloom cantaloupe; since 1920.
PEPPER	Anaheim	75	7 ½"x2"	[TMV]	AKA the "New Mexican Chile;" moderately pungent; turns deep green to red. Very productive.
	Ancho Poblano	90-110	4-6"		One of the most popular chilies in Mexico. Known as Poblano when fresh; Ancho when dried. A must for making chili Rellenos.
	Golden California Wonder	73	4"		Really sweet; thick-walled square shape. Very productive; golden-yellow at full maturity.
	Early Jalapeno	65-75	3 ½"x1"		Green or red, mild to medium-hot; upright plant. Good fresh or pickled. Widely adaptable.
	Jimmy Nardello	80-90	8-10"		Sweetest non-bell pepper when ripe. Tapered fruit, excellent fresh or lightly sauteed.
	Yankee Bell*	60-80	4-6"		Good for northern climates. Pick at 80 days for red.
PUMPKIN	New England Pie	102	4 lb.		The standard pie pumpkin, for generations! Great yielder in good seasons. Also known as Small Sugar.
SQUASH	Buttercup*	100-105	3 lb.		Turban-like shape; winter squash w/sweet, deep-orange flesh. Easy to store.
	Cocozelle Bush	53			Rich-flavored Italian heirloom w/light green stripes.
	Honeynut*	100	4-5"long	[PM]	A dark orange mini butternut w/high sugar content.
	Partenon*	48		[F1]	An early producer of tasty, uniform dark-green zucchini; sets fruit without pollination.Tolerant to PM.
	Yellow Crookneck	58	4-5"		Consistent yield of firm buttery-flavored, fruit on large plant. Best picked small.
