<b>Chlogga</b>	60	2-2.5"		A pre-1840 Italian heirloom; very tender. Sweet, mild flavor; beautiful rings inside.
<b>Touchstone Gold</b>	55	2.5"		Golden roots, bright yellow flesh; retains color when cooked. Sweet flavor; early maturing.

<b>DeClicco</b>	50	3-4"		A compact Italian heirloom. Blue-green head with many sideshoots.

<b>Kalibos,red</b>	75-85	2-3lbs		Beautiful purple pointed heads. Great for slaws & salads! Old eastern European variety w/high sugar content.
<b>Napa, Bilko</b>	65-70	10-12"	F,DM	Mild sweet crunchy Chinese cabbage with large football-shaped Savoy heads.
<b>Pak Choi, Luck Dragon*</b>	35-40	8"		Sweet & crunchy green stemmed baby pak choi. Slow to bolt.

<b>Flash*</b>	55	16-23"		Vates-type hybrid for repeated harvests. Upright; heavy yielder that produces through the cooler and warmer months.
<b>Cucumber</b>				
<b>Lemon</b>	55-65	3-4"	AN,CUB	Very crisp, round, abundant yellow fruit. Eat like an apple, right from your garden! Great for pickling; heirloom.
<b>H 19 Little leaf*</b>	57	3-5"	A,ALS,B,S, CMV,PM	Bright green pickle on compact vines. Sets fruits with no pollination.
<b>Manny</b>	55	5-7"	PAT,CVYV, PM	Thin gourmet crisp spineless cukes! Widely used in Europe. Uniform thickness; self pollinating allows for early yields.
<b>Parisian Gherkin</b>	60	3"		Proper Gherkin; French heirloom with very few seeds.
<b>Shintokiwa</b>	60	9-10"		A long, thin, crunchy Japanese cucumber w/ sweet taste!
<b>Straight Eight</b>	58	8"		Popular heirloom slicer w/ excellent flavor; mild and crunchy.
<b>Striped Armenian</b>	60-70	12-18"		Non-bitter heirloom w/ excellent flavor; Unique in appearance. A member of the melon family.
<b>Suyho Long</b>	61	15-18"	DM	Delicious, crispy burpless cucumber from China. Sweet fruit can be picked at any stage. A favorite here at Russells! Very prolific.

<b>Ping Tung Long</b>	65	2x18"		Shiny, deep-lavender fruit. Great flavor, very good yield; excellent disease resistance. An heirloom from Taiwan.
<b>Noong Ta Klong Pea</b>	90			Pea size eggplants crucial in Thai curries w/ a bitterness. Some consider it a spice rather than an eggplant. Used medicinally too.
<b>Travata</b>	75	2x9"		Traditional Italian dark purple heirloom eggplant; produces early.

<b>Basil, Cardinal</b>	60			Beautiful red blooms but just as delicious as plain basil!
<b>Basil, Eleonora</b>	65			Spicier than typical basil w/larger leaves; resistance to bolt.
<b>Basil, Obsession DMR*</b>	70-80		DM, F	Downy mildew resistant basil with Italian flavor & good bolt resistance.
<b>Basil, Genovese</b>	88			Most popular variety in Italy; very fragrant & tasty.
<b>Basil, Holy</b>	90			Hairy purple stem & purple flowers. Musky scent used medicinally in Hindu and Ayurveda culture. Great for pollinators!
<b>Basil, Thai</b>	92			Popular Basil w/ taste essential for Thai cooking; compact.
<b>Borage</b>	80			Small, edible flowers with a mild cucumber flavor on large plants.
<b>Bulbing Fennel</b>	50-80			The bulbous, crisp stem can be grilled, steamed or served raw like celery! Use fresh leaves in salad or sauce.
<b>Cilantro</b>	55			Like the leaves, the flowers and seeds are edible too, Attracts beneficial insects. Nice mild flavor.
<b>Dill</b>	45			Robust against bolting; freezes well. Delicious ;attracts bees.
<b>Parsley, Italian Flat</b>	70			Classic flat leaf variety.
<b>Parsley, Triple Curled</b>	75			Double curled very hardy and prolific parsley.
<b>Marigold, Lemon &amp; Tangerine Gem</b>	60			Floral flavor maigolds with hints of citrus and spice; slightly bitter.
<b>Nasturtium Kaleidoscope Mix</b>	60			A popular choice for adding color to salads. Peppery-flavored foliage is also edible. Flowering annual that blooms all summer!

<b>Drunken Woman Looseleaf*</b>	55			Leaves are green w/emearld tips; ruffled. One of the last to bolt!
<b>Encore Sweet Mix</b>	28-40			A stunning mix of textures and colors; gourmet lettuce blend!
<b>Freckles Romaine</b>	50-70		V,F1,F2,NT	Unusual, attractive spotted Romaine; tasty flavor. Slow to bolt. Pick young, or as full-sized head.
<b>Gallsse</b>	30-55		DM	Very reliable, compact green oak leaf-butterhead. Bolt resistant.
<b>Little Gem Romaine</b>	40-60	4-6"		Small personal size crisp -mini romaine! Also known as Sucrine; a gourmet English heirloom w/ excellent flavor. Heat tolerant.
<b>New Red Fire</b>	51		BOR,DM,T B	Looseleaf with tender, sweet, light red ruffled leaves. Among the last to bolt!
<b>Pirat Butterhead</b>	60		DM,TB,WM, BHR	Tender sweet variety; the highest disease resistance among butterheads. Green, with red tips.
<b>Susans Red Bib Butterhead</b>	60			Red, ruffled, bitter-free, attractive, tender bib lettuce. Heirloom.

<b>Cajun Jewel</b>	60-65	1x7"		Dwarf type plants produce well in our cooler climate. Heirloom with large pods and no spines. Great in soup!

<b>Walla Walla</b>	90-120	4-6"		Famous sweet and mild heirloom variety.
<b>Yankee</b>	108	3-4"	DM,PR	Medium-large round bulbs. Excellent yields and storage.

<b>Aji ChInchi Amarillo</b>	59	3"x.5"		A key ingredient in Peruvian cuisine. Good yields of medium-high heat, fruity orange-yellow peppers growing on large plants.
<b>Anaheim Hatch, Big Jim</b>	75	9"x2"		Most famous New Mexico green chili; great for stuffed rellenos.
<b>Ancho-Poblano</b>	68	5"		Extra large mildly hot chile; Stuff fresh and roast for chiles rellenos poblanos a Mexican cuisine must have!
<b>Chimayo*</b>	75	3-5"		Heirloom chili from the Chimayo valley of northern New Mexico. Thin skin makes it easy to dry, great for roasting, smoky flavor.
<b>Early Jalapeno</b>	75-80	3"		Very productive, mild to medium hot; pick green or red. Good fresh!
<b>Fish</b>	80	2"		Attractive, curving, fruit. Originated in 1870s from the Caribbean. Full-bodied flavor enhances shellfish.
<b>Komodo Dragon</b>	110	1.5-2"		Possibly the hottest peppper! Fruity flavor before the pain!
<b>Marla Nagy's Transilvanian*</b>	70	6" x 3/4"		Dry for hot Paprika or use fresh in salsa's. Looks like Cayenne but tastes altogether different! Large strong productive plant.
<b>Padron</b>	60	1-1.5"		Famous Spanish heirloom. Eaten as appetizers (tapas).
<b>Pasilla Bajlo</b>	85	7"x1"	TMV	Thin-walled, slender, blackish-green heirloom has almost no heat; Mainly dried; smoky flavor. Delicious peppers used in many ways!
<b>Shishito</b>	60	2-4"		Sweet green-red Japanese pepper; prolific heirloom. Popular as tasty pan fried appetizers w/ salt & olive oil!
<b>Thai Hot*</b>	80-90	1x1/2"		A favorite hot pepper for Asian stir fry dishes. Compact plants.

<b>Jimmy Nardello</b>	80-90	8-10"		Sweet, long, thin-skinned, bright red frying pepepr. Heirloom from Southern Italy; Eat fresh or lightly sauteed.
<b>Lunch Box Snack Mix</b>	55-75	2"		Beautiful, mini-sized, sweet and flavorful fruits. Great for a snack!
<b>Yankee Bell</b>	60-95	3-5"		Good yields of medium bells; bred especially for northern climates.

<b>Zucchini, Cocozelle</b>	48-58	8-11"		Good for small gardens and container planting. A tender & flavorful Italian heirloom; dark green with white striping.
<b>Zucchini, Costata Romanesca</b>	54	6-8"		An Italian heirloom w/nutty flavor and a distinctive appearance. Great picked at about 6".
<b>Zucchini, Golden Glory</b>	50	7-8"	PM, MMZ, ZYMV	High yields w/excellent disease resistance. Bright yellow fruits; heirloom.

<b>Buttercup</b>	115	6.5"		Popular vining plant yields sweet Northern New England favorites!

<b>Rainbow*</b>	30-60			Vibrant amazing color sections. Excellent cold tolerance too!
<b>Ford Hook Giant</b>	50	24"		Old favorite white stem variety w/broad, savoyed leaves. Very bolt & cold tolerant compared to colored varieties. Stunning & popular!

<b>Blacktail Mountain</b>	70	8-12 lb		Very early heirloom; superb for the north, but grows well in heat and drought. Sweet, red flesh, dark rind.
