Cosmonaut Volkov	65	8-16 oz	Ind		A Ukrainian heirloom. Offers true tomato taste! Fruits early, even in cold summers. Nice acid-sweet balance.
Church	85	1-2 lb	Ind		A very productive heirloom yielding delicious beefsteaks. A Russell's favorite!
Pruden's Purple	75	12 oz - 1+lb	Ind		Dark pink heirloom w/ excellent flavor rivals Brandywine in taste and earliness. Excellent producer with great flavor; flattish fruit.
