Candyland Red	55	1/2 "	Ind		Smaller than most cherries but just as sweet; tidier growth in big clusters.
Chocolate Cherry	70	1"	Ind	FI	Extremely flavorful. Unique dark-chocolate color. Hangs in clusters. Resistant to leaf mold; heirloom.
Indigo Rose	70-80	2-3"	Ind		Dark-purple, tangy-sweet fruit; acidic flavor. Also used ornamentally.
Italian Ice	65	1 oz	Ind		Prolific. Hangs in clusters. Sweet, mild, flavorful, ivory-white cherries. A great snack while in the garden!
Juliet	60	1 oz	Ind	A,EB, LB	Clusters of elongated fruit on vigorous vines. Full-flavored. Twice the size of a grape tomato.
Mexico Midget	60-70	1/2"	Ind		Very reliably, tiny red cherries w/ prolific yields. Tasting just like a salad tomato!
Mountain Magic	66	2 oz.	Ind	V1,2 EB, LB	High yield of crack-resistant, red saladette clusters!
Rapunzel	70	.75 oz	Ind		Bright red cherry on extra long cascading trusses.
Red Grape	50-60	.3 oz	Ind	LB	Mild, bite-size grape tomatoes. Very popular heirloom.
Sugary	80	2 oz	Ind		Huge yield; super-sweet cherries, pointed at ends. Hangs in clusters. AAS winner. A Russell's favorite.
Sungold	57	.5x1"	Ind	F1, F2, TMV	A favorite golden-orange cherry; thin skin. To prevent cracking, pick before heavy rainfall.
Sunsugar	62	.5 oz	Ind	F, TMV	A popular, vigorous bearer of sweet, orange cherries. Thin skin; great crack resistance!
Super Sweet 100	78	1"	Ind	VF1	More disease resistance and fruit than Sweet 100. Sweet red cherries that split in rainy conditions.
Sweet 100	65	1"	Ind		Vigorous; bears up to 100+ sweet, red fruit. High vitamin C content. Very popular hybrid.
Sweet Chelsea	67	1-1.5"	Ind	V, F, NT	A jumbo red cherry. Disease-resistant, crack-tolerant.
Sweet Pea Currant	69-75	.25"	Ind		One of the smallest, red currants. Intense rich, sweet flavor! Grows to 4-6 ft; yields hundreds of fruit; heirloom.
Yellow Pear	70-78	2"	Ind	F1, F2, ASC	Vigorous vines yield petite, pear-shaped yellow fruit. Few seeds. Heirloom.
